

Job Description: **Remote Automation Service Technician Lead/Helper
(Measurement Technician)**

Location: **Shreveport, LA**

Requires: Minimum 2 years of related experience for Lead, and some related experience and/or training for Helper.

This job requires the individual to install, calibrate/configure/program, and maintain/support remote industrial automation systems and related electrical and electronic measurement process instrumentation. This involves analyzing requirements for field installation, scheduling and coordinating work with customers and other contractors, job preparation of required materials and tools, installing mounting hardware, process instrumentation and valves/chokes, wiring, junction boxes, flow meters/tubes/computers, solar panels/batteries, and radio/cellular communications equipment at many different remote gas well sites in the field. It also involves complete check out of a functioning system before and during startup of a new production gas well. Technical experience with industrial measurement process instrumentation is required, troubleshooting skills are necessary, moderate computer skills are required, and logic programming skills are desired. Good technical, coordination, organization, and communication skills are important, as the job requires daily interaction with customers and others at various industrial job sites. Job safety and related awareness is always a must.

The individual must remain alert and aware of his surroundings at all times while working or travelling to a job site. The individual must demonstrate and maintain the mental acuity required to complete his assigned duties in an efficient, timely, safe and productive manner. The individual must be able to maintain composure and productivity while handling multiple tasks. The individual must be mature, be able to make sound decisions, and be able to exercise independent judgement and discretion in the best interests of the company and the end customer. The individual must behave and be able to interact with customers, vendors, contractors, and employees at all levels within the organization in a professional, business-like manner, while treating all such individuals with dignity and respect.

This job is demanding in terms of technical knowledge, skills, commitment to see the job through to completion, and varying schedules and work hours. Urgency and pressure for prompt, accurate results is routine. It requires the individual to efficiently handle technical problems while maintaining a professional and positive relationship with the customer, supervisors, and co-workers. Concern for the consequences of action and

alertness to quality are key components in this job. The job calls for the responsiveness and energy to work long hours and handle varying schedules.

The job requires driving to/from customer industrial sites on a daily basis. The individual must have a current legal driver's license and reasonably clean driving record in order to operate company vehicles, and must operate company vehicles safely and legally at all times. Individuals must be capable of and diligent about compliance with safety rules and regulations in customer industrial environments. Attention to detail and awareness of potential safety hazards is expected at all times. Maturity and sound judgement are essential to working in this environment. The typical working environment is outdoors at remote well sites and the individual must be able to work outdoors in ALL types of weather conditions when necessary.

There is a requirement to carry certain equipment, tools, and products that weigh as much as 50+ pounds, and be able to safely load and unload these items.
